

# Tineke and Maurits van Geel

Tineke van Geel has been teaching international folk dancing since 1975. Her specialty is Armenian dance, and she has visited Armenia every year since 1985. She attended classes at the Choreographic School and the Pedagogical Institute in Yerevan, and trained with various amateur groups. Because of her worldwide teaching (11 European countries, the USA, Canada, Australia, Taiwan, Japan, and more) Tineke has been recognized by the Armenian government for her extraordinary devotion to and energy in promoting Armenian dance, music, and culture.

Maurits van Geel has been active as a dance teacher, lecturer, and choreographer since 1975. He was a guest lecturer at the Dance Academy in Rotterdam, and a dance consultant in Amsterdam. From 1988 to 2011 he worked at the International Dance Theater, serving as artistic director for 15 years. He has traveled, taught, and conducted research on Roma dances in numerous countries.





Both Tineke and Maurits are excellent teachers, and bring a great deal of energy to their dance sessions. They will be coming to Dayton from teaching at Stockton Folk Dance Camp, on their way back to The Netherlands.
