

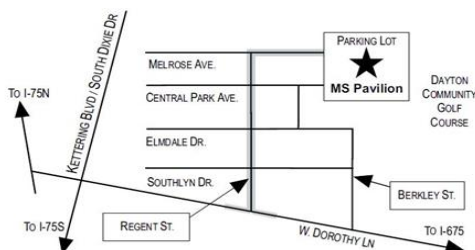
LOVE THE PAVILION ?

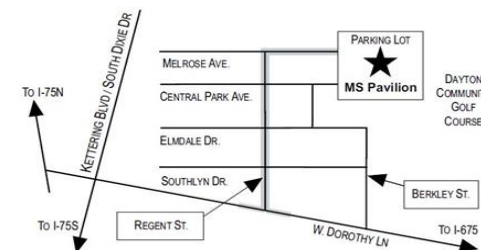
